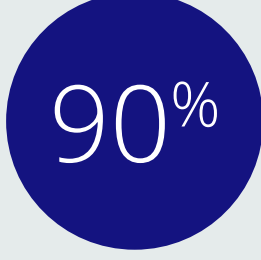
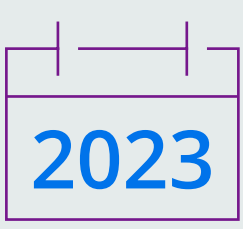

Target for 90% of NHS trusts to have an EPR by December 2023¹

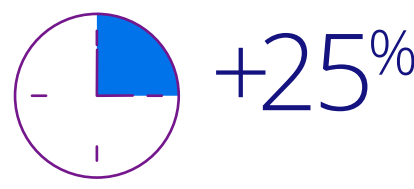


Use of pen and paper for clinical noting has halved in the last 7 years²

Clinicians spend a third of working hours on clinical documentation²

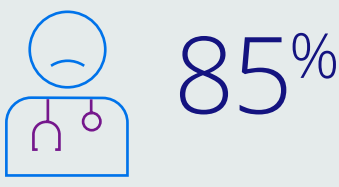


...And this is 25% more time spent on clinical documentation than 7 years ago²

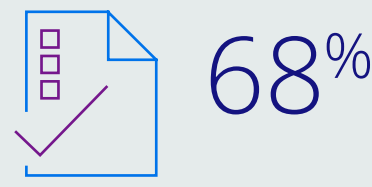


Clinicians spend 62 minutes per day searching for missing information²

85% of NHS healthcare professionals felt the burden of clinical documentation is a significant contributor to burnout³

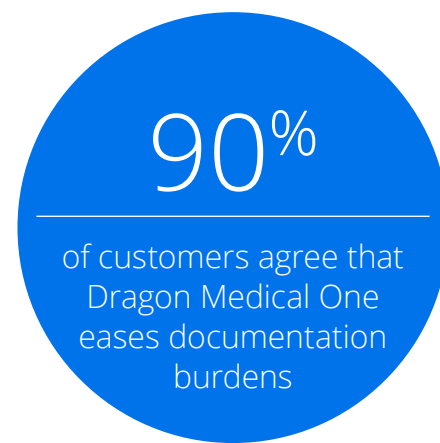


68% of clinicians felt it was likely or very likely their notes would be more complete with more time²
