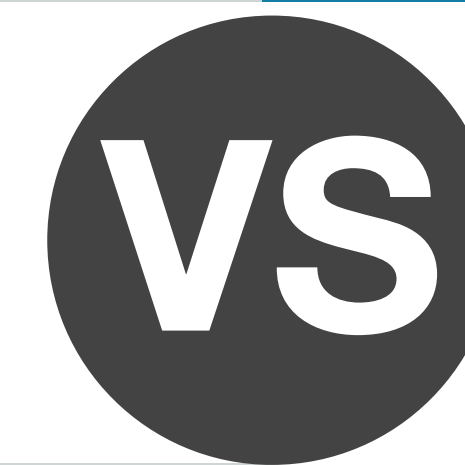

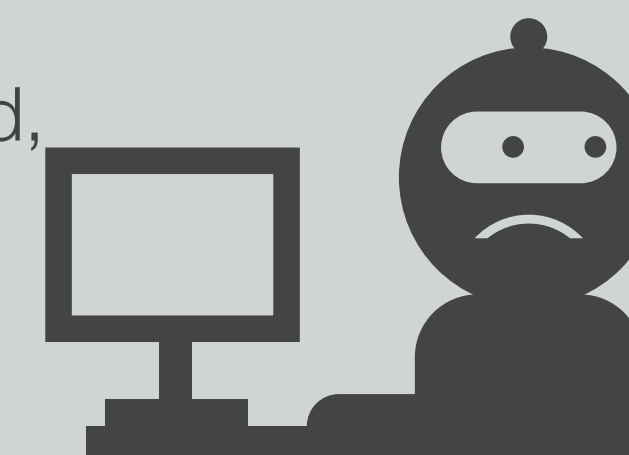

RISK MANAGEMENT

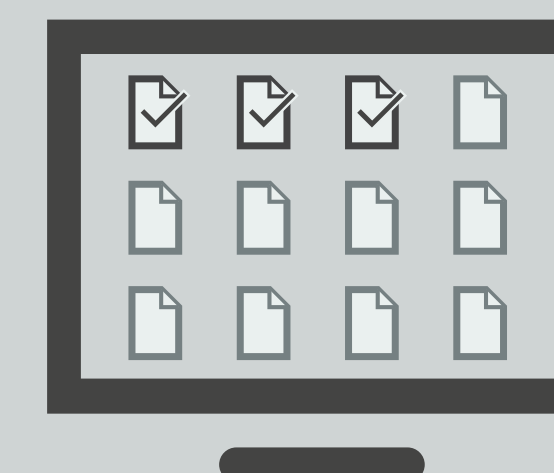
